Anthony Bourdain III: *F*cking Great Noodles*

I have already had a lot of interest for this print after sharing my [latest Anthony Bourdain III: *F*cking Great Noodles* mosaic](#) a few weeks ago.



There are some subjects I love creating more than once. This is my third Bourdain piece to date, and yet every single mosaic of him is so different. As a big noodle lover myself, I was thrilled to incorporate him eating a bowl of noodles for this piece. I challenged myself to try out a new technique of using liquor bottle rings to give more texture to the noodles on his chopsticks and I really like how it turned out.

If you zoom in, you'll of course find some "easter egg" caps that pertain to Tony's life: a **Hanoi** cap, donated from a bottle cap collector in the Netherlands, since the original photograph of AB eating noodles took place there; **1956**, **2018**, his first and last years on earth, **New York** where he was born, **"A"** & **"B"**, and an **angel** and **devil** to represent his inner conflicts and advocacy for mental health.

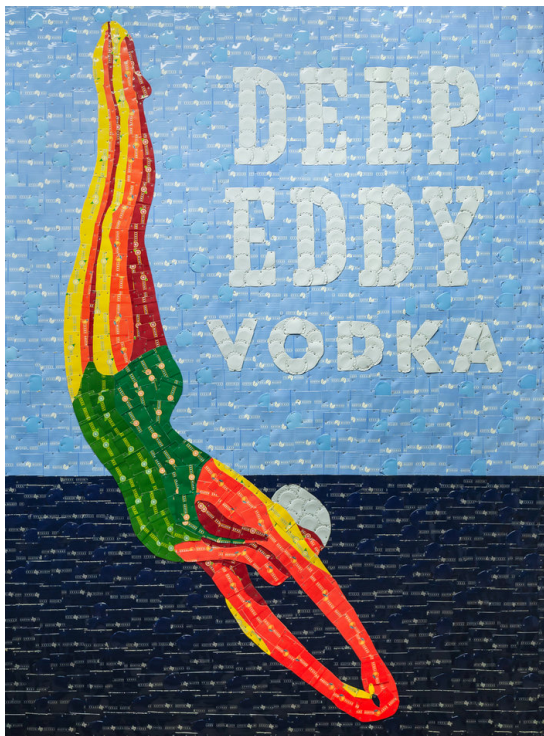


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Deep Eddy Vodka Diver

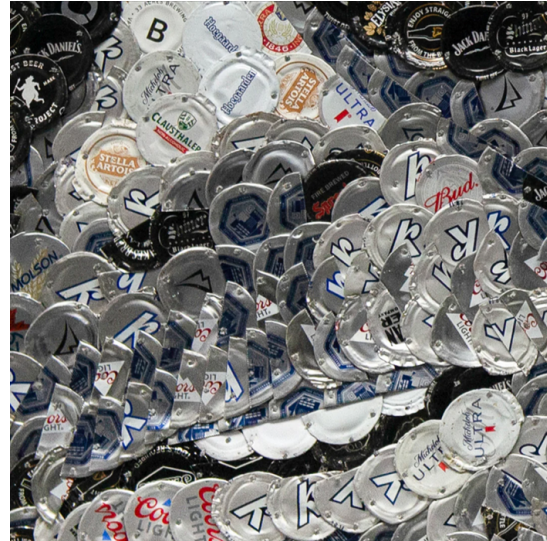

I am stoked to have limited prints of my Jerry Garcia mosaic available for this release. [Check it out](#) for some awesome artwork, and more!



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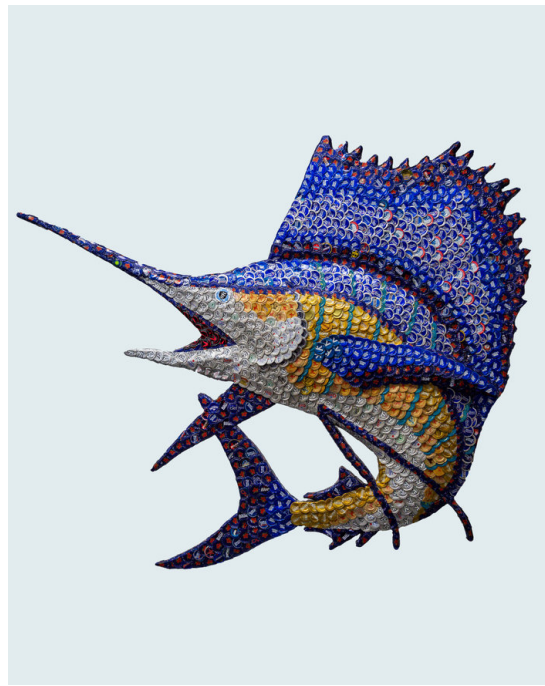
