I was incredibly excited to receive a commission of a Post Malone piece for a client which will be a surprise for her husband's upcoming 70th birthday gift! I have been wanting to create a mosaic of Posty for quite some time now. The client requested him in his cowboy era, and I felt this design suited him perfectly as it captures his iconic smile with his platinum crowns and diamond veneers, his face tattoos, the cowboy hat, tip of his guitar, and of course his overall cheerful vibe.



I incorporated many unique caps - or "Easter Eggs" - that pertain to Post's life and music:
Post, M, a **Dallas Cowboys** cap because his Dad worked for the team, A **New York Yankees** cap signifying his birthplace, **95** marking his birth year, several **Texas** caps grounding his home State, both **Jelly Belly**, **Hank's**, and **Compass** caps referencing his songs with Jelly Roll, Hank Williams Jr, and Kanye West, respectively, an **Ace of Spades** cap, among many, referencing his many tattoos, plus NUMEROUS more caps illustrating his songs and albums. This makes for a really fun way to provide more for the client to observe up close, while being able to appreciate the piece in its entirety when they view it from farther away.

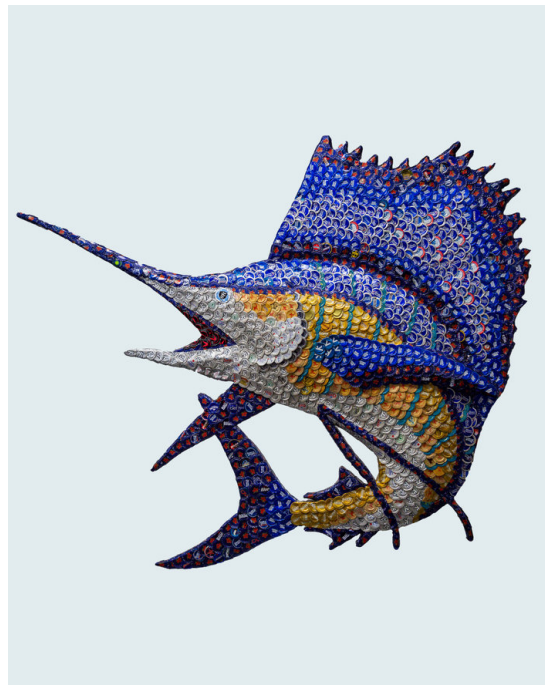
